Work was resumed following a conference in January with Governor Douglas at the state house between representatives of the manufacturers and the operatives, at which he agreed to investigate business conditions in the industry and report a margin between cotton and cloth on which an increase in the scale of wages should be paid. On his subsequent report a system of wage dividends based on the margin between the quotations for specified quantities of cotton and cloth went into effect, and continued until July 2, 1906, when the wage scale prevailing before the strike was restored. Approximately 7,000 persons removed from the city during the strike which, however, had been marked by uniform good order. The census in the spring of 1904 had shown a population of 113,602. That of 1905 revealed but 106,645,...
