Hypocotyl 5 mm. long, terete, thickest at base, pinkish, especially towards cotyledons. Cotyledons oblong, petiolate, bright-green or purplish-red throughout, obtuse, entire, with margin ciliated with glandular hairs; lamina 4mm. x 3mm., horizontal, bent almost...
